**Show Rules**

Hi Point – 1 rider/1 horse combination  
One Hi Point award per rider/horse combination  
*In order to be considered for HI PT you must declare  
which HI PT you are competing for*

**\* Not to be counted toward Hi Point**

Jr Handler-Age 18 and under  
Sr Handler-Age 19 and over  
Green Horse 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> year showing  
Novice Rider not to have won 3 blue ribbons under saddle  
Jr Horse-Age 5 and under  
Sr Horse-Age 6 and over  
Green Horse training devices **are** allowed  
Show clothes optional/**boots required**  
Stallion handlers must be **OVER** 17 years old  
For Hi-Point ties, tie-breaker class will be class #18  
Halter HI PT Will Be announced following the halter Championship Class.  
English HI PT will be announced during the lunch break  
ALL other HI PT awards will be announced at the close of the show  
You must be present to receive your award, they will **not** be shipped

**Hobby Horse Rookie Rewards** is a western walk-trot horsemanship class for novice riders at open horse shows. Rookie Rewards class winners receive a \$100 Hobby Horse gift certificate and ribbons for first through fifth place.

**Hi Point Class List**

Awards to class average winners 1<sup>st</sup> thru 5<sup>th</sup>

HI PT categories are tabulated off of the class average placing. 1<sup>st</sup>=5pts, 2<sup>nd</sup>=4pts, 3<sup>rd</sup>=3 pts, 4<sup>th</sup>=2 pts, 5<sup>th</sup>=1pt

HI PT will be awarded to the person with the highest number of points in the category he/she declares.

**English HI PT:** 1-12, 15-18, 21-32, 35-44 (Awarded during the lunch break)

**Western HI PT:** 1-12, 15-18, 47-50, 54-65, 68-77

**Novice Rider HI PT:** 14, 20, 21, 46, 53, 67

**13 & Under HI PT:** 1-12, 15, 18, 21, 24-29, 32, 35, 38-44, 47, 50, 54, 57-62, 65, 68, 71-77

**14-18 HI PT:** 1-12, 16, 18, 22, 24-28, 30, 32, 36, 38-44, 48, 50, 55, 57-61, 63, 65, 69, 71-77

**19 & Over HI PT:** 1-12, 17, 18, 23, 24-28, 31, 32, 37-44, 49, 50, 56-61, 64, 65, 70-77
