IMPORTANT NEWS:

The 2008 Zone One Horse show is being held August 20-24, 2008 at the Idaho

Horse Park in Nampa, Idaho. As you know, we have 6 judges at Zone.

So that means that for all of you who are looking to get a lot of judges in a short period of time (especially with the rising cost of fuel), you will be able to get 14 judges in 10 days!

New for 2008! APHA membership is now required for all exhibitors to show

A new rule change for 2008 requires that all exhibitors must have an APHA membership to show. Youth competitors must have an individual AjPHA membership to show in youth classes. Membership

is only required for exhibitors to be eligible to show; however, as in the past, horse owners must be APHA or AjPHA members to be eligible to receive APHA awards.

Joint or ranch/farm memberships are accepted for adult competitors; however, an individual exhibitor card must be obtained and presented at the show. Joint memberships **do not** satisfy the youth requirement. TCF moved their Yearling Longeline Futurity to the Cascade PHC show September 5,6 & 7,2008, to allow more time to get the yearlings ready. Most of the large futurities for performance horses are in the fall, including yearling longeline.

Weanling Halter, Non Pro Weanling Halter, 2 Year Old Non Pro Western & English, Oregon PHC, Eugene, OR October 10,11 & 12. TCF will be hiring 2 extra judges for this show, to have 3 judges for Non Pro and 3 different judges for the Open weanlings.

Mare nominations are due March 1, 2008 to avoid late fees.
